Message from the Principal

Dear Spartan Families,

The 2022-2023 school year is just around the corner! The staff at Red Bluff High School is excited for the upcoming year which promises to be filled with excitement, energy and change. We are also prepared to welcome our newest Spartans, the class of 2026! It is our goal to make each student feel welcomed and connected as we work to support them to reach their fullest potential. When students return to campus on August 10th, they will notice some changes. The daily schedule for the 2022-2023 school year will have modifications from last school year. (See website) Another change is that Tuesdays and Wednesdays will serve as our modified block days with Wednesday remaining our early release day at 1:19 p.m. **An additional change for the 2022-2023 school year will include new procedures regarding cell phones and dress code. Cell phones, airpods, headphones and smart watches will not be allowed during instructional time. These devices will be required to be powered off and in a student's backpack during class.** Students will be allowed to use their phones during passing periods, and at lunch. For a complete description of the district's cell phone procedures, please refer to the student/parent handbook. Regarding the dress code, students may not wear a sweatshirt hoodie over their head during instructional time and blankets will not be allowed on campus. RBHS will have a single lunch period for all students and the campus will remain closed for all 9th and 10th grade students.

The administrative team will remain the same as the 2021-2022 school year. Mr. Levi Gonzalez returns for his 2nd year and will work in the area of discipline and restorative justice. Mrs. Mitzi LoPiccolo returns for her third year as an Associate Principal. Mitzi wears many hats in her role at Red Bluff High School; however, her main focus is student support services. Mr. Don Ray returns for his third year with the Spartans. Don is our Athletic Director/Administrator and also is in charge of attendance.
