

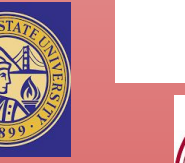
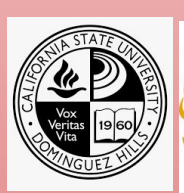

# Application Window

- Application window is Open!
- Priority application - **closes November 30th**
- 1 application to apply to any of the 23 universities.
- \$70/application fee/per college - there is a fee waiver for up to 4 universities



We recommend completing your application **BEFORE** Thanksgiving break so we can help/review. Counselors will not be available during break.

# Admission Requirements

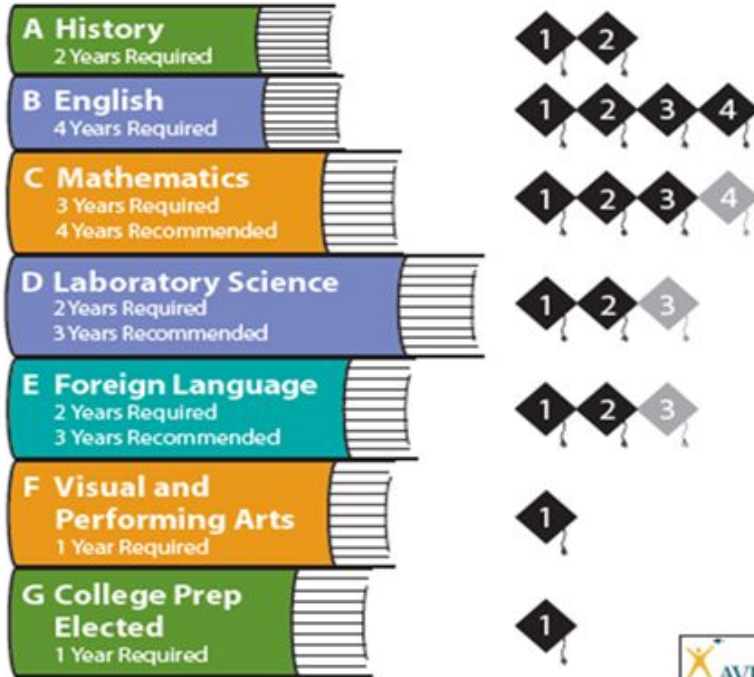
What are universities looking for?

1. GPA - minimum of 2.50 (local service area) usually 3.0 or higher
2. A-G requirements have been met
3. ACT/SAT scores will NO LONGER be used for admission purposes - if submitted, they would be used for math and English placement
4. If application is for an impacted program, higher ‘a-g’ GPA thresholds, supplemental criteria will be used.

A–G Requirements\*

California State University • University of California



\* Grades of C or better required.



- College prep courses (P)
- Must be passed with a C or better
  - Earning all Cs = 2.0 GPA. This is lower than the minimum. Aim for at least a 3.0
- Math: must successfully pass Algebra 2



California residents and graduates of California high schools will be eligible for admission by earning a 2.50 or greater “A-G” GPA.

### For Impacted programs:

Campuses will use a combination of students' “a-g” GPA and supplemental factors to determine admission eligibility. Supplemental Factors that campuses may use include:

- Number of courses exceeding minimum “a-g” requirements,
- GPA in math and or science courses,
- Household income,
- Extracurricular and leadership involvement,
- Educational program participation in high school
- Other available information that would inform the campus admission decision.

## ■ Campus Impaction:

- *A campus receives more eligible applications in the initial filing period than there are enrollment spaces available for the class level.*

## ■ Program Impaction:

- *A campus receives more eligible applications for a specific undergraduate program in the initial filing period than there are enrollment spaces available.*

# Freshman Application Checklist

When you're ready to begin your application to the CSU, be sure you have these items on hand:

- Unofficial transcripts (both high school and college transcripts, if applicable)** You'll be asked to enter all the courses you've completed on your CSU application; those that are currently in progress; and any you plan to take. Transcripts will be requested by campuses as needed.
- Your Social Security number**, if you have one.
- Your citizenship status**
- Credit card or PayPal account** Application fees are due at time of submission.
- Annual income** Your parents' if you are a dependent; your income if you are independent
- Educational Program, Work and Extracurricular Participation Information** You will need to provide the years you participated in college preparation programs and your average number of hours per week of work and/or participation in extracurricular activities.
- Information needed to apply to EOP (if applying)** See the [Apply to EOP website](#) for information about materials needed to complete the optional EOP application.
- Test scores** Optional; if you have taken or plan to take the ACT, SAT, AP, IB exams, you may include the information on the application. Reporting test scores is not required. SAT and ACT scores will not be used for determining who gets admitted into the CSU. If you are accepted, the campus will use official test scores to for placement into mathematics and English courses.
- California statewide student ID** Optional; every K-12 student in a California public school is assigned an ID number. The number should be printed on your transcript.

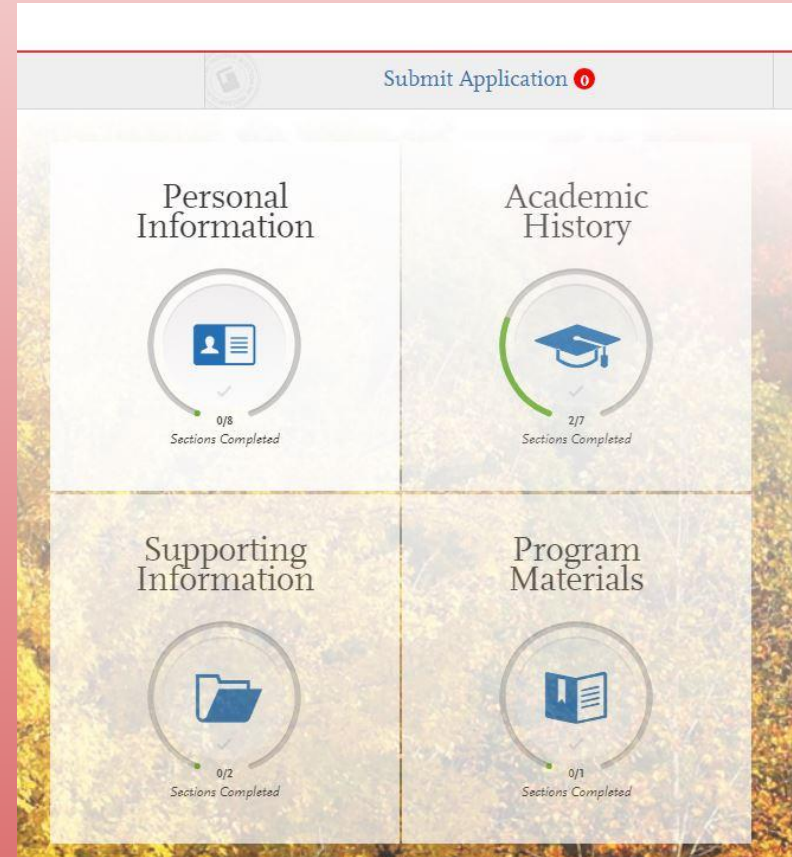


# Advice from Admissions Officials

---

- **Make sure to use legal name on ALL documents**
- **Apply broadly – have Plan A, Plan B, Plan C**
  - Apply to Chico State (Local CSU Priority)
- **Check housing application requirement when applying**
- **Comply with ALL deadlines & campus instructions**
  - *Transcripts, req. tests, deposit deadlines, intent to register, financial aid requirements, orientation registration*
- **Electronic communication**
  - *Check e-mail regularly*
  - *Remove spam filters*
- **Maintain senior grades/finish well**
  - *D/F in any senior class (even non A-G) could result in admissions cancellation at some campuses*
  - *Must maintain eligibility index for campus/major*



# After you've submitted your application:

1. You'll receive an acknowledgment e-mail or letter from each campus.
2. Set up your online student portal at that campus.   
Everything goes through portal.
3. January and February, you may get a notification in your student portal about any missing items, such as financial documents or recommendation letters.

Depending on the campus, you should receive your admission decision in March (ish)

(meaning whether you've been admitted, denied admission, or waitlisted for admission).

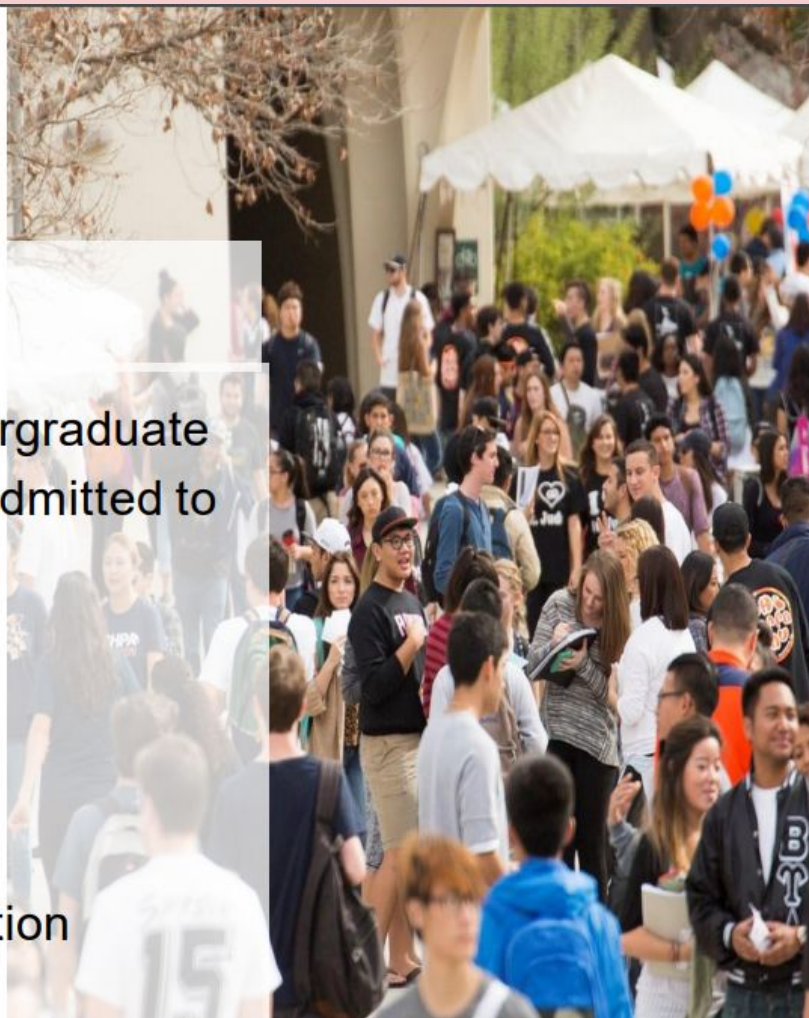
If you've been accepted, you must submit:

- your "intent to register" by **May 1**
- Submit a deposit to secure your admission

Again, each campus will let you know how to do this via your portal account.

## Redirection

- Applies to all CSU-eligible undergraduate applicants who have not been admitted to **any** CSU campus
- Applies to:
  - First-time Freshman
  - Associate Degree for Transfers
  - Upper Division Transfers
- Considered CA residents for tuition purposes





# Redirection, Cont.

- Eligible applicants will be notified of option to be redirected
  - Fall – After April 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Spring/Winter – After November 1st
  - Sent to Cal State Apply to provide response and select non-impacted campus first and second choice
- Applicants have 21 days to respond via Cal State Apply
  - Then an additional 14 days
- If no response will be redirected to a non-impacted campus with capacity
  - Provides a safety net to all CSU eligible applicants

# Things to Remember!

- Do **NOT** use your school email address
- Don't wait until the last minute
- Write down your username, student ID and your password
- Set up your student portal account
- Check portal and email regularly
- Be aware of housing and orientation deadlines
- In June, submit your final transcripts
