

SAT information

CSU campuses

No longer uses ACT or SAT examination in determining admission eligibility for all CSU campuses.

Student will be eligible to apply with a 2.5 or greater "A-G" GPA (Academic GPA)

If a student falls below this GPA requirement, other factors will be considered in determining eligibility.

UC campuses

UC will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships.

Students will be eligible to apply with a 3.0 or greater "A-G" GPA (Academic GPA)
Students in the top 9 % of CA high school graduates will be guaranteed a space at a UC campus if space is available.

Private schools/out of state

Check the university website for specific information.

Reasons to consider still taking the SAT/ACT

- There are some scholarships that will consider a high SAT/ACT score. If you are a strong test taker, this might be a benefit in trying to capture a scholarship.
- If you are in 11th grade and you want to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. Must score in the top 99% for this scholarship.
- Some private and out of state schools will offer you a tuition discount based on a minimum GPA and test score.
- Universities can still use your score for your class placement in your college freshman classes.
- Students interested in military academies should take the test.

SAT

The SAT currently consists of two main sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math.

Sending scores

Once you've taken the SAT test, you can list the Cal State Apply institution code, so that Cal State Apply can store your scores for any CSU campus to retrieve. The Cal State Apply institution code for the SAT is **3594**.

When you sign up for the test, you can choose up to 4 universities to receive your scores for free. After you've taken the test, it will cost you money to request that your scores get sent to universities.

If you are an athlete, you can submit your scores using the code **9999**. Then your scores will be sent to the NCAA Eligibility Center.
