IN – HOUSE SUSPENSION PROGRAM

The in school suspension program provides an alternative to home and class suspension by providing a supervised on school site placement where students may remain in an educational setting, but isolated from other students.

When a student is assigned the in house suspension program, the student must check into the office on time (8:00 AM) and prepared to work the entire day. Teachers are notified and classwork will be delivered to the student as teachers are able to produce it. The student will be allowed to take assessments in the classroom with prior teacher approval.

In – House students are isolated from other students throughout the day. They eat lunch separate from the rest of the student population. They will need to bring their own lunch or money to purchase lunch from the cafeteria. A time will also be granted to all students to get a lunch from the cafeteria if needed. No outside food will be delivered to the students. Food which is dropped off for in house suspension will be kept in the office.

In - House Suspension Rules:

- 1. Students will arrive on time. If tardy, they will be suspended for the day (admin discretion).
- 2. Students will remain in their seats and be silent unless given permission to do so.
- 3. No electronic devices.
- 4. Students are expected to work, reflect and not talk or engage in activities with other students.
- 5. Students will be engaged in work the entire day. If students are done with their work, they need to bring a book to read.
- 6. No sleeping is allowed.

Students who fail to attend, follow the rules or are uncooperative will be sent home on a home suspension. Students who continue to violate the in school suspension rules will have further consequences at administration discretion.
